



Celebrations

Use videos to capture celebrations. Celebration recordings can be preplanned, such as student presentations, a group accomplishment, or class celebrations. They can be small, unplanned moments that deserve to be highlighted, such as a lightbulb moment (for both the students and the teacher), a random act of kindness, or a happy family moment shared by a student. Build community by watching videos with students or teachers to celebrate together.

GET STARTED

- → Set up mobile device and Swivl Robot in the classroom
- → Launch **Teams by Swivl** app and tap the Recording feature
- → Ensure primary marker is being worn by the teacher
- → If multiple markers are available, consider placing additional markers around the classroom to capture student dialogue

DIRECTIONS

- 1 Using the primary marker or the app, begin recording
- 2 When recording is complete, title and save from mobile device*
- Review the recording on Teams by Swivl (on a computer not mobile app) at a later time
 Using time-stamped comments, indicate celebrations at specific points in time
- 4 At a set date and time, or when everyone needs a boost, share the celebrations (recommended on a regular basis), including your own, with the class
 - Be intentional about celebrating the positives to work on building up the classroom culture
 - Consider playing the video for the class
