Narrates expectations, offers verbal instructions, and facilitates peer modeling



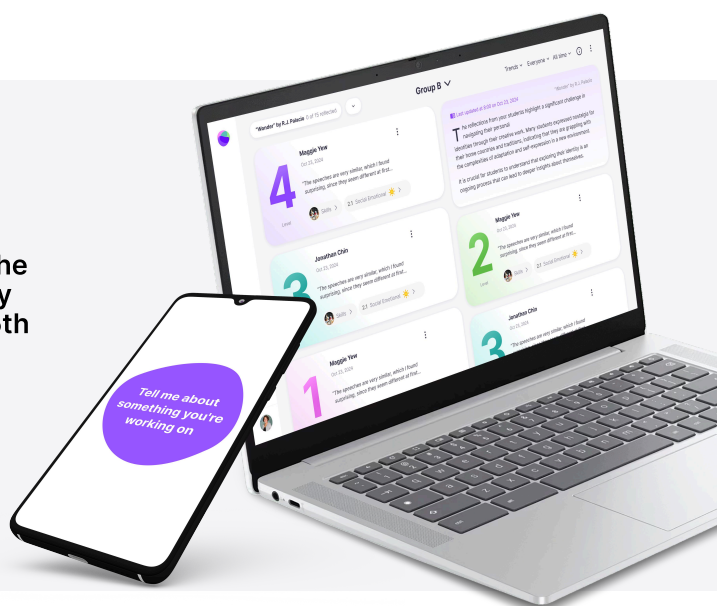
5. Versatile tools
