

How one teacher sets up M2

1 Launch M2

- Press & hold the power button for 2-3 seconds (circle button on the top of M2).
- Create an account on mirrortalk.ai or download the app.
- Log in to the M2. It's easiest to scan with your phone if you have the app.

2 Put on the lanyard located on the back of M2

- Press the button above the remote to release it.
- Turn the remote on (power button is on the side.)
- Wear the remote necklace for the best audio transmission.

3 Select "Start" to begin your M2 session

If you want to provide more detail:

- Click the activity name at the top center.
- Focus for feedback: include standards, objectives, or describe what the lesson is about today.
- Grade level.
- Live tips: this is how often M2 will give you feedback. It is automatically set to 2 minutes.
- In-ear Audio: You can wear earbuds and get audio tips as you teach.
- Screen saver: You can turn the blinking eyes off!
- Click X

4 M2 is already listening!

Through your lesson you have 3 options:

- **Let it go:** M2 will gather and provide feedback on your lesson in which you will reflect on at the end of the block/day.
- **Hold to speak:** press and hold the button to ask M2 a question or give a command. This allows for an interactive experience!
 - sample prompts/commands - next page
 - used for more detail and in depth queries
- **Tap for Magic:** M2 provides you with a helpful response based on your lesson.
 - brief interactions, summary, quick response without much detail.

You can either hold to speak/tap for magic by pressing on the M2 or the dot button on the lanyard.

5 End of the lesson

At the end of the lesson, click the X to end the session.

When you have time, go to your dashboard and locate the activity.

Read the Insights:

- **Summary:** this is M2's summary of your lesson.
- **Feedback:** See [this document](#) for information on what the feedback means. At the bottom is a purple button for you to reflect on the feedback. This is important! Reflecting on our practices helps us grow!
- **Transcript:** A full transcript of your lesson
