

# Chat with M2 prompts: Planning & instruction prep toolkit

### Clear goals

Purpose: Use M2 to define and strengthen instructional goals.

- Help me create a clear, measurable goal for [insert content].

### Rigor & thinking

Purpose: Use M2 to ensure alignment and cognitive demand.

### Student talk & engagement

### Lesson design
